



I understand the requirements for my pet(s) health certificate to travel outside the United States including exam, vaccines, possible bloodwork (such as a titer test), microchip, time limitations for travel and follow up appointments.

My destination country requires an APHIS 7001 form that must be endorsed by the Department of Agriculture (USDA). I am aware that I must mail the certificate and supporting documents to the USDA office in New York using overnight shipping such as UPS, FedEx or USPS Priority Express. ***I must also include a check for \$38.00 per each health certificate made payable to the USDA.***

A return prepaid label must also be purchased so documents can be returned. Certificates are generally processed the day they are received providing there are no serious omissions or other problems. ***I understand that it is VERY IMPORTANT that the return prepaid label should have my name as both the sender and the recipient. If a prepaid label is not included my documents will be returned using USPS First Class mail which will delay receipt of my package. Shipping labels cannot be paid for with a credit card.***

I am also aware that the endorsement can be accomplished by making an appointment in Richmond at the local USDA office with the understanding that these ***appointments are very limited and no walk-ins are accepted.***
