- We recommend you contact the airline for their specific requirements.
- We also recommend you contact the embassy of the destination country for current rules and regulations. Nationwide 411 for embassy numbers: 1/202-555-1212.
- Due to airline regulations, the appointment for the certificate must be scheduled the 10th day before the departure date.
- If vaccines or required tests were done elsewhere, you must provide this information prior to your appointment.
- Rabies certificates must be signed by the DVM who administered the vaccine. **If this was done somewhere else, you must provide three (3) copies, all signed in blue ink.**

- Certificates must be endorsed by the Department of Agriculture (USDA) and can be taken to the Dept. of Agriculture in Richmond or can be overnighted to the USDA office in New York.
- This is a stamp of approval for the pet to leave the country. Each certificate endorsement requires a payment of \$38.00 (by check) made out to the USDA. Multiple pets are permitted on one certificate for one fee.

2 Choices for Endorsement:

- 1) The USDA office in Richmond requires a scheduled appointment. It is very important that you schedule this ahead of time. These appointments are very limited and they will NOT accept walk-ins. This method of endorsement is recommended because if there are any issues with your health certificate or other provided information, they will inform you at the appointment and give you time to correct any mistakes.
- 2) You can choose to mail documents to the USDA office in New York. You may choose to overnight the paperwork at your own expense, along with a pre-paid overnight return envelope addressed to Dumfries Animal Hospital. Once the paperwork is returned to the hospital, we will contact them for pick up. This method is not recommended because if there are any issues with the required paperwork, you are not made aware until your documents are returned.
